The Clerk/Manager reported that he along with DM Trickett met yesterday with Mr. Steve Prestley and Chris Haley of BioMaxx to discuss the setting up of flow meter and reporting with regards to the Federal Wastewater compliance. It was also noted that members from the Towns of Cupids, Clarkes Beach, Spaniards Bay and Upper Island Cove were in attendance.

Motion: DM Trickett/Hiscock resolved that we accept the quote from BioMaxx in the amount of \$8,580.00 plus tax over a year reporting to be in compliance with the Federal Wastewater Guidelines. In Favour 6; Opposed 0; Carried

With regards to Targa, the Clerk/Manager reported that he received a number of complaints from residents and Schools with regards of not knowing when it was taking place. The Clerk/Manager noted he sent out an email but Targa didn't send out notice to the public which caused confusion. Council noted they would keep this in mind when Targa seeks support for the race next year.

The Clerk/Manager noted that on two occasions he tried to meet with the owner of 6-14 Curtis Lane to discuss the Barricade he has installed blocking of a portion of the public entrance of Curtis Lane.

Motion: Mercer/Broughton resolved that we write the owner of 6-14 Curtis Lane giving him one (1) week to have the Barricade removed from the present location to his boundary or Council will have it removed at his expense. In Favour 6, Opposed 0; Carried.

Mayor Rodway reported that he along with DM Trickett and Councillor Broughton attended Sea Cadet Week at the Royal Canadian Legion in Brigus on Sept 30/14 and signed the proclamation.

Mayor Rodway also noted he presented Mrs. Freda Ryan with her 80th Birthday Certificate on Oct 6/14.

The Dept of Municipal & Intergovernmental Affairs presents annual long service awards to recognize the significant commitment of councillors across the province to individuals who serves 12, 16, 20, 25, 30 and 35 year categories. DM Trickett was pleased at this time to present to Mayor Byron Rodway his 12 year service award.


Motion: Youden/Mercer resolved that our meeting be adjourned until November 4th, 2014. In Favour 7; Opposed 0; Carried.
